The case of Steven Engel in 1962 caused the United States Supreme Court to remove a single prayer from public school. Studies have proven* that grades, school violence, and family life radically changed after this seemingly simple mandate (including the untimely assassination of President Kennedy the following year).

Brimstone and his staff make numerous references to this, indicating this is what formed *NightWorld*. How could a simple law affect so much? Why would removing prayer from public school cause a long-term decline in public schools for decades to come?

What does this suggest about the presence of God- His Word, His ways, His commandments- in our daily lives and in our society? Do you think it's important to honor God in society? In school? In government?

Some argue that having God's Word and His principles in our society is intolerant and excludes other belief systems. How does this compare or contrast to John 14:6, Acts 4:12, and 2 Peter 3:9?

Discuss the endless numbers of things that only work one way. Why are any of these things similar to Jesus being the only way to salvation?

If you are a believer in Christ, how can you be "light in a dark world" (Matthew 5:16)? And why is it important to stand for your faith, especially in an unbelieving society (Ephesians 6:10-20)?

Why do you think Scarlet (temporarily) regrets taking a stand while Wick stands throughout the whole ordeal?
